Rules:

- a. Classes open to members only.
- b. Entries accepted at staging time only: 6.00 – 6.45 pm on Friday 7th.
- c. No entry fee, no prize money.
- d. Items in all classes must have been grown by the exhibitor for at least 3 months.
- e. One entry per person in any class.
- f. For the purpose of differentiation in this schedule see the 'Classification of Daffodils' sheet. ('Daffodils' = 'Narcissus').
- g. Please use the containers provided for Classes 1 – 17.
- h. Please name varieties where possible.

Three trophies will be awarded:

- **Caithness Paperweight** for Best in Show.
- **Pollock Plate** for best exhibit of daffodils (Classes 1 – 12)
- **Froyle Beech Bowl** for Class 16.

A Garden Gift token is given to the competitor with the highest points total in classes 1 – 24 (1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point).

Classes:

1. Trumpet daffodil, yellow. 1 bloom.
2. Trumpet daffodil, yellow. 3 blooms.
3. Trumpet daffodil, white. 3 blooms.
4. Trumpet daffodil, bi-coloured. 3 blooms.
5. Large cupped daffodil. 3 blooms.
6. Small cupped daffodil. 3 stems
7. Double daffodil. 3 stems
8. Triandrus daffodil. 3 stems, usually 2 or more pendant flowers to a stem.
9. Cyclamineus daffodil. 3 stems, 1 flower to a stem (refer to classification sheets).
10. Tazetta type daffodil. 3 stems, 3 or more single flowers per stem.
11. Poeticus (Pheasant eye type) daffodil. 3 stems. Stamens 3 above 3.
If all at the the same level enter flowers in Class 5.
12. Daffodil, any other type not included in the above. 3 stems.
(Daffodils from Divisions. 7, 10, 11, 12, and 13)
13. Tulips. 3 blooms.
14. Polyanthus. 3 stems.
15. Flowering shrub. 1 stem.
16. Mixed Spring flowers (may include shrubs). 9 stems. 3 or more varieties.
17. Mixed foliage. 6 stems. 3 or more varieties.
18. Cactus or succulent in a pot.
19. Flowering pot plant. Up to 18 cm/7" internal pot diameter.
20. Foliage pot plant. Up to 18cm/7" internal pot diameter.
21. A Phalaenopsis orchid in a pot.

22. A pot of Alpines, 1 type. Up to 18cm/7" internal pot diameter.
23. Rhubarb. 3 sticks.
24. Any vegetable. 1 specimen.
25. A Spring posy in water. Not to exceed 25cm in width. To be judged by popular vote.

- **Reflections**
- **A Flower Portrait**

To be judged by popular vote.

Photographs to be no larger than 8" x 6". They may be cropped.
